

GIGAVAC's REACH Declaration

The European REACH Regulation 1907/2006 on Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), Annex XVII entered into force in June 2009, and affects all companies producing, importing, using, or placing products on the European market. The aim of the REACH regulation is to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment from chemical substances. Gigavac's substances management system follows and complies with the current revision of the REACH Regulations on the substances as identified by ECHA (European Chemical Agency).

Gigavac does not import, manufacture or otherwise supply chemicals. All of Gigavac products are "articles" within the meaning of REACH. Gigavac's products do not contain any Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) in excess of 0.1% by weight within the definition of the list of SVHCs published by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) effective as of 16 Jan 2020.

Similarly, Gigavac's shipment packaging, also considered "articles" under REACH, do not contain SVHCs based upon the 100% material content declarations we obtain from our suppliers.
